3. Rules and Regulations

The ISSF World Cup will be conducted according to the ISSF Rules and Regulations "Edition 2017 – Second Print V1.1 01/2018". Detailed information is available on the ISSF website www.issf-sports.org.

ISSF Juries (Jury of Appeal, Competition Jury, RTS Jury, and Equipment Control Jury) will be designated by the ISSF to supervise the ISSF World Cup. Qualified Range Officers holding applicable ISSF licenses will conduct the competitions.

Rifle / Pistol Equipment

Equipment Control will be conducted according to ISSF Rules using approved, calibrated instruments. Pre-competition testing is not mandatory, however, athletes are responsible for competing with legal equipment and clothing. All athletes are urged to submit any doubtful equipment and clothing to Equipment Control for checking before the competition. All athletes are subject to being selected for random post-competition testing and will be disqualified if their equipment or clothing is not legal according to ISSF Rules.

Rifle Clothing

All rifle athletes must have ISSF seals with serial numbers on their jackets and trousers. Any rifle jackets or trousers that do not have ISSF seals must be submitted to Equipment Control for inspection and the affixing of a seal before the athlete's first competition. Jackets and trousers that were previously inspected and have an ISSF seal continue to be valid except that athletes with more than one jacket or trousers must report to Equipment Control before their first competition to confirm which jacket and which trousers they will use. All other seal numbers for that athlete will be cancelled. Athletes that wish to replace a registered jacket or trousers with a new clothing item must bring that item to Equipment Control for inspection and a new seal. Previous seals will then be cancelled. Rifle athletes can have only one active jacket and trousers at any time.

Rifle Clothing Post-Competition Stiffness Testing

If one panel of a rifle jacket or trousers tests 2.9 or lower, the stiffness device must be recalibrated and the panel must be retested. If it fails again, but all other panels pass, the athlete will not be disqualified, but a written warning must be given to the athlete and the ISSF seal must be cut off. The athlete can continue using this clothing for that day in that event. If two or more panels fail, the athlete must be disqualified (DSQ).

Air or CO₂ Cylinders

It is the athlete's responsibility to ensure that any air or CO2 cylinder is still within its validity date. This may be checked by Equipment Control.

4. Participation

Individual Events

ISSF Member Federations may enter a maximum of three (3) athletes per World Cup event and up to two (2) additional athletes to shoot for "MQS only".

The additional "MQS only" athletes will be listed separately according to their results, but without ranking – these results cannot be recognized as World Records.

Mixed Team Events

ISSF Member Federations may enter a maximum of two (2) teams consisting of one (1) man and one (1) woman per mixed team event.

Maximum Entry

The maximum number of starts per event is the number of athlete entries that can be accepted for each ISSF World Cup event. Range capacity is determined by the available shooting time and the number of available firing points.

If cancellations are subsequently received, entries from the waiting list will be entered on a first come, first served basis. ISSF Headquarters and the Organizing Committee will cooperate to determine if additional entries from the waiting list can be accommodated.

ISSF ID Number

All athletes must sign an "Athlete's Declaration" and have an official ISSF ID number issued before participation in the ISSF World Cup.

Athletes without ISSF ID number will not be allowed to participate. ISSF ID numbers can be obtained from the ISSF Headquarters by using the official application form.

Quota Places and MQS

Quota Places for the 2020 Olympic Games Tokyo (JPN) will be awarded according to the Qualification System. Detailed information is available on the ISSF website www.issf-sports.org. Results obtained during this ISSF World Cup will be recognized as MQS for the 2020 OG.

Athlete biographies will be distributed and photos will be taken.

5. Entry Process

Preliminary and Final Entries for Athletes and Officials must be submitted to ISSF Headquarters. Entry Forms are provided, but ISSF Member Federations are urged to use the ISSF Online Registration Service.

All other Registration Forms must be returned to the Organizing Committee (see also: "Summary of Deadlines").

Final Entries

ISSF Member Federations must forward their Final Entries directly to the ISSF HQ. The Final Entry Deadline (30 days before the Official Arrival day) is **27 JUL 2019**.

Please use the ISSF Online Registration Service http://entry.issf-sports.info, or exceptionally complete the Final Entry Forms (Annex 3) and return them by email or fax to the ISSF Headquarters.

Late Entries

If the maximum number of athlete entries have not been reached, late entries will only be accepted until the Late Entry Deadline (3 days before the Official Arrival day) which is **22 AUG 2019**.

Important Note: Until the 3 days Late Entry Deadline, the following changes in the Final Entries are possible without restriction and additional fees:

- a) Change of names / athletes within an event
- b) Change of Status (World Cup athlete ↔ "MQS only" athlete) within an event.

Any additional entries received after the Late Entry Deadline, from 23 AUG 2019 onwards, may not participate.

Entry Confirmation upon arrival

All Team Leaders of ISSF Member Federation Delegations must report to the OC Entries Official and confirm their Final Entries. The confirmation must be completed before 12:00h on the day before the Pre-Event Training.

Entry Changes after the Late Entry Deadline

From 23 AUG 2019 onwards, only the following changes in the Final Entries are permitted:

- a) Replacement of a registered athlete by another already registered athlete in another event can be made only before 12:00h on the day before the Pre-Event Training for that event.
- b) Change of Status in an event: an "MQS only" athlete can replace a withdrawn "World Cup" athlete. The withdrawn "World Cup" athlete may not shoot for "MQS only". The exchange of athletes within an event is not permitted.

Cancellation

Any ISSF Member Federation that reduces the number of athletes listed in their Final Entries after the Final Entry Deadline (27 JUL 2019) must pay applicable entry fees and hotel room cancellation costs according to the number of athletes and entries on the Final Entry Forms originally received. If the applicable fees and costs are not paid, no member of that federation may participate.

Payment of Entry Fees

Payments may be made only in US Dollars (USD) and Euro (EUR). Money can be exchanged at the GIG International Airport. Money cannot be exchanged at the Shooting Range. Payment by Credit Card or traveler's checks will be not accepted. Preferably all payment must be made by bank transfer with data below.

Accreditation Process

All persons involved in the ISSF World Cup (Athletes, Team Officials, ISSF Officials, OC Officials, Media Persons) must have accreditations that clearly identify the accreditation holder (with photograph, family name and first name, nation and function) in order to use the local transportation and to enter controlled areas on the shooting range.

Accreditations (for persons registered before the Late Entry Deadline and with photograph in the ISSF database) will be prepared by the ISSF Headquarters and Organizing Committee. All other accreditations will be prepared by the ISSF World Cup Accreditation Office.

7. Immigration and Customs Requirements

Entry Visas

The participating federations, which require entry visa into Brazil, are kindly requested to obtain it before departure from their country. If needed, please fill in the enclosed Visa Support Form (Annex 7) and send it to the Organizing Committee (wcbra2019@gmail.com) in time but not later than **24 MAY 2019.** Upon request, the Organizing Committee will send Official Invitation Letter to apply for their entry visa at the Brazilian Embassy or Consulate in their respective countries, or where required in case of countries having no diplomatic relations with Brazil.

The Brazilian Shooting Sport Confederation has no influence on the embassy and can provide the invitation regarding the ISSF World Cup only!

Gun License

All participating federations must declare all of firearms and ammunitions brought to Brazil for the ISSF World Cup in advance. They are kindly requested to complete the Firearm and Ammunition Form (Annex 8) and must return it together with passport copies of each athlete as early as possible, but not later than **28 JUN 2019.** Forms must be typed in **PC ONLY**, not handwritten or transmitted by fax. A fee of USD 30.00 will be charged to each athlete and official for the clearance of weapons and/or ammunition that will be checked in Brazil, including air guns.

The transit permits will be delivered by the Brazilian Army after checking the firearms and ammunitions at the airport of arrival in Brazil. Firearms must always be accompanied by their transit permits wherever they go.

Custom Clearance – Arrival

All delegations are requested to arrange the **GIG Airport (Rio de Janeiro Tom Jobim International Airport – Galeão)** for arrival and departure. International airlines mainly can be reached to GIG Airport directly. If there is any country that the first stop in Brazil will be GRU Airport (Sao Paulo), the Custom Process will be not automatic and can take much more time than in GIG. For those countries it's strongly recommended to have a connecting flight with minimum 5 hours from GRU to GIG, because Brazilian government requests that the custom formalities for all luggage and firearms must be made at the first international airport of Brazil Territory upon arrival and at the last one upon departure. There will be an additional charge of USD 40.00 for each clearance made at GRU airport, regarding costs with the local dispatcher who will assist in the clearance process.

The Organizing Committee is not responsible for losses of flight connections and baggage at GRU before arriving in GIG. Countries with connecting flight in GRU must fly to GIG in a domestic flight. It will also bring consequences about limit of quantity and luggage weight.

Arrivals to Brazil by other airports than GIG or GRU will not be accepted. Arrivals to Brazil by Bus or Car will not be accepted also.

IMPORTANT

According to Brazilian law, it's mandatory that all members of the Delegation fill in the e-DBV on-line document for Customs (Traveller's Electronic Declaration of Goods) prior to your arrival in Rio de Janeiro at the following site:

The Organizing Committee strongly recommends to bring 2 copies of the e-DBV printed and correctly filled to the ease of the arrival.

Custom Clearance - Departure

The clearance of firearms and ammunitions will take place in 2 steps:

1st step – at the competition venue: each athlete, after ending his last event, must withdraw his weapons and equipment from the armory and present them with the documentation received upon arrival at the airport to the Brazilian Army office. After the check procedures, the athlete must take the firearms and equipment with their documentation to the hotel or to the airport, if that is the day of his departure.

2nd step – at the airport: upon arrival to check in, the athlete must present his firearms and ammunitions and their documentation to the customs authorities (Revenue and Federal Police officials) for final clearance.

Athletes Under 18 Years Old

According to Brazilian Federal Law 8.069/14 (Child and Teenager Statute), athletes up to the age of 18 must have the appropriate authorization form completed and provide proper documentation to be eligible to compete.

This authorization is obtained through a Mandatory Court Permit, wich requires a special procedure. The procedure for minors participating in competitions requires the follow documents:

- Authorization form signed by the parent or legal guardian of the athlete, expressly containing
 the name of the person who is authorized to accompany and who will be entirely responsible
 for the minor during the competition;
- Copy of the ID or passport of the athlete that contains his/her photo and the name of his/her parents or legal guardian;
- Copy of the ID or passport of the athlete's parents or legal guardian that signed the authorization form;
- Copy of the passport or ID of the person indicated in the authorization form to be responsible for the athlete during the competitions days;
- Medical certificate;
- Schooling statement.

The lack of documentation or proper procedure to obtain authorization of the minor may obligate the athlete to abandon the competition, due to on-site inspection from Minor's Court authority or even cause the cancelation of the competition, so the Organizing Committee will not allow the participation of a minor athlete who does not meet these requirements.

We kindly request that the federation previously inform the Organizing Committee of the participation of a minor athlete, to obtain guidance on legal procedures.

9. Travel and Transportation

Travel – Arrival
