BULLETIN #1

August 25th-28th, 2016 in Trollhättan, Sweden

WELCOME

The Swedish Shooting Sport Federation is honored to invite all member federations of the Nordic Shooting Region (NSR) to participate in the 2016 Nordic Shooting Championships in Pistol, Rifle, Running Target and Shotgun for Juniors and in Shotgun for Seniors.

Only shooters and teams from the member federations of the NSR may compete for the titles "Nordic Junior Champion" and "Nordic Champion". (General Rules 5.1 and 5.4.1)

The Championships will be organized August 25th-28th 2016 in Trollhättan, Sweden.

VENUES

Disciplines in Pistol, Rifle will take place at Skogssäter Skyttecentrum, except the 10m rifle and the 10m pistol events, which will be conducted at Granngårdens Air Shooting Range in Trollhättan. The distance between the two venues is about 15-20 minutes by car depending on the traffic.

Running Target events 10 m will be conducted at Granngården.

Disciplines in Skeet, Nordic Trap and Running Target 50 m will be conducted at Jaktskyttebanorna at Hultet, located about 500 m from Skogssäter Skyttecentrum.

Trap event will be conducted at Skepplanda Skyttecentrum located about 50 km south of Trollhättan.

NSR GENERAL RULES

The participation in the junior events is regulated by <u>the NSR General Rules for Junior Championships</u>. The participation in the senior events is regulated by <u>the NSR General Rules for Senor Championships</u>.

AWARDS

Awarding ceremonies will take place on Friday, Saturday and Sunday at the shooting ranges. Nordic Shooting Region special medals will be awarded to the Champion (gold), the shooter who places second (silver) and the shooter who places third (bronze) in each event in the program. Medals are awarded to individual shooters only if a minimum of six shooters participate.

The winning team in each event will be awarded gold medals, one medal to each member of the team. Medals are not issued to teams if there are two or less teams competing. (General Rules 13.1-13.3)

ENTRY FEES

950 SEK per person per event is to be paid together with the return of Preliminary Entry Form "A". Late entry is 1425 SEK per person. Entry fees are non-refundable (General Rules 7.1) and must be paid together with the return of Preliminary Entry Form "A" no later than April 25, 2016. However, Entry fees will be refundable in case shooting events will be cancelled due to few participants.

PAYMENT DETAILS

Payment to cover all entry fees must be received no later than April 25, 2016. Payment to cover all accommodation fees must be received no later than **August 1, 2016**. Payment must be free of any bank fees.

CATERING

Lunch will be served at the shooting ranges and must be ordered and prepaid. Lunch must be ordered in the Final Entry Form "B-Officials".

BANQUET

Further information will be given in Bulletin #2. In case banquet will be arranged tickets have to be ordered in FINAL ENTRY FORM "B-OFFICIALS" sent out together with Bulletin #2.

TRANSPORT

Transport arrangement will be made when required for participants arriving with flight to Landvetter Airport as well as arrangement for shuttle transport between the hotel and the shooting ranges. A Travel Form D will be sent out together with Bulletin #2. All transport reservations are binding and must be made no later than July 1st. Information on transport fees will be given in Bulletin #2.

CUSTOM CLEARANCE

Athletes arriving to Sweden need European Firearm pass, except for air weapons. All athletes need to declare their firearms at Custom.

Athletes with valid Finish, Norwegian or Danish arms license (or equivalent) can use the Customs' electronic firearms declaration.

STORAGE

Storage of weapons and ammunition will be arranged at Skogssäter Skyttecentrum. This requirement is not applicable for air rifles and air pistols.

JURIES

Juries shall be formed from all participating federations. Participating federations shall be bound to contribute a **minimum of 5 Jury Members, at national federations expense**, to advise, supervise and assist where necessary, the Organizing Committee. All Jury Members should be ISSF License holders. Shooters and Team Officials must not be members of a Jury. (General Rules 12.1 - 12.4)

Nomination of Jury Members must be given in final entry form "B-Officials" not later than July 1st, 2016. The organization has pre-booked a number of single rooms for Jury Members and Technical Delegate at **Scandic Swania Hotel**.
